## FINE YOUR LOWA SHOE SIZE

Find out in just three easy steps what shoe size we would recommend for you.
What do you need for that? A credit card, a wall, an A4 print of this template and maybe some adhesive strips.

## STEP 1

Print this template on A4 paper. To check whether your printer has exactly met the right scale, you can use a ruler to measure the centimetre at the bottom right.


Place your right foot on the template. Make sure that your heel touches the wall. Now you can read off your shoe size from the table.

## STEP 2

WALL

Find a free space right next to a wall Then place the printout on the floor and use the credit card as a placeholder. To do this, place the credit card next to the wall with its side edge, so that the opposite side touches the marking on the printout. If necessary, you can stick the credit card to the floor with adhesive tape to keep everything in place.

## OUR TIP:

Also measure your left foot. Your feet might have different sizes. If this is the case, go with the size of your bigger foot.
